Housing

Federally-funded housing options:

<u>Public Housing Apartments</u>- provides housing for eligible, low-income families, the elderly, and persons with disability. The rent charged is usually no more that 30% of one's income. Application must be made in person at the housing authority near you.

Section 8/ Housing Choice Voucher is a federal government's major program for assisting very low income families, the elderly and the disabled. The voucher are administered locally by public housing authorities. If accepted you will receive a voucher to assist with rental assistance, which means you will pay 30% of your income to rent. Most housing authorities have very long waiting list and sometimes only takes applications during certain times.

Subsidized Housing Complexes (no vouchers)- You apply directly with the apartment complex. They offer rent for 30% of your income, these slots are for the elderly and those who have a disability.
